### NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

After the miracle of Jesus walking on water, the disciples exclaimed, "Truly, you are the Son of God" (Matthew 14:33). Most Christians will probably never experience such a dramatic miracle. Like Elijah, we await the manifestation of God in other moments. 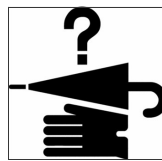

### NOTES FROM THE PRINCIPAL....

This week our kindergartners begin summer camp at Saint Anselm School. Some will come in bundled in shyness. Others will bounce down the hallways as if they have been here every day. And behind every child will be parents who look at these moments with a mix of emotions—pride, sadness, trepidation, joy. They will worry about their children, and they will celebrate the small but mighty victories. And that is how it is with children—no matter what their age.

So how do we prepare our younger children for success in school? Every time your young child can do something on his or her own, let your child do it. Let them carry their own lunch boxes and book bags. Certainly by the time a child begins kindergarten, he or she should have some home chores. We look for so many ways to show our children we love them, and sometimes we then do too much for them. Real love gives them wings so that they may fly.

And so the great balancing act begins: let go and holding on. It will be a challenge that will extend their entire lives (and ours). And when in doubt, prayer is a great "how to" book for all of us! May God be with every family in Saint Anselm Parish as you prepare your children for a wonderful year at school, no matter what school it is or what grade level!
